

Tree Identification

Forestry 1 – Follow the Path: In this book you will explore different types of trees and tree parts, characteristics of different forests, what forests need to grow and thrive, and the different products people get from trees and forests.

Book Requirements: Complete 6 activities each year. Complete page 2 helper name, page 4 complete & add helper initials. Budding Knowledge/Branching Out responses should be put on separate sheet of paper and stapled in book where activity is located. Use different color ink for years 2 & 3.

BCYF Exhibit Requirements:

Year 1 - Using an actual cross section of a tree (tree trunk section cut 4" thick) identify the age of the tree and seasonal changes. Refer to page 5 in your project book.

Year 2 - Using a Tri-Fold, display the water cycle. Refer to pages 28 and 29 in your project book.

Year 3 - A display on two forestry activities completed this year in Follow the Path plus your "Branching Out" activities notebook

WV State Fair Exhibit Requirements:

All Years – A poster or display on two forestry activities completed this year in Follow the Path plus your "Branching Out" activities notebook and project book.

Forestry 2 – Reach for the Canopy:

Book Requirements: Complete 6 activities each year. Complete pages 2, 3 and 4 each year. Budding Knowledge/Branching Out responses should be put on separate sheet of paper and stapled in book where the activity is located. Use different color ink for years 2 & 3.

BCYF Exhibit Requirements:

Year 1 - Using a Tri-Fold, display a West Virginia map and identify state and national forests located in our state. Refer to pages 14 - 15 in your project book.

Year 2 - Using a poster, design and describe a fire triangle. Refer to pages 26 - 27 in your project book.

Year 3 - A display on two forestry activities completed this year in Reach for the Canopy plus your "Branching Out" activity notebook.

WV State Fair Exhibit Requirements:

All Years – A poster or display on two forestry activities completed this year in Reach for the Canopy plus your "Branching Out" activities notebook and project book.

Forestry 3 – Explore the Deep Woods:

Book Requirements: Complete 6 activities each year. Complete pages 2 & 3 each year. Complete page 5 in year 3. Budding Knowledge/Branching Out responses should be put on separate sheet of paper and stapled in book where the activity is located. Use different color ink for years 2 & 3.

BCYF Exhibit Requirements:

Year 1 - Using a Tri-Fold, display and identify six different tree barks. Refer to pages 8 and 9 in your book.

Year 2 - Using a Tri-Fold, display and identify the five methods of tree pruning. Refer to pages 26 - 27 in your project book.

Year 3 - A display on two forestry activities completed this year in Explore the Deep Woods plus your “Branching Out” activity notebook

WV State Fair Exhibit Requirements:

All Years – A poster or display on two forestry activities completed this year in Explore the Deep Woods plus your “Branching Out” activities notebook and project book.
