**Rabbit 1 – What’s Hoppening** (3 year book) This project covers identifying breeds, handling and showing rabbits, identifying rabbit parts and equipment, recognizing a healthy rabbit, reading a pedigree, and kindling a litter.

**Book Requirements:** Complete 7 (seven) activities and page 3 each year. Helper initials are required. Bounding Ahead responses should be put on a separate sheet of paper and stapled into book where activity is located. For years 2 & 3 use different color ink. The animal record guide is required and due to your club leader in September along with your project book.

**Rabbit 2 – Making Tracks** (3 year book) In this book you will learn to recognize body types, judge and show rabbits, tattoo a rabbit, keep records, identify diseases, and administer medication, record growth rates, and market products.

**Book Requirements:** Complete 7 (seven) activities and pages 3 & 4 each year. Helper initials are required. Bounding Ahead responses should be put on a separate sheet of paper and stapled into book where activity is located. For years 2 & 3 use different color ink. The animal record guide is required and due to your club leader in September along with your project book.

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**Rabbit 3 – All Ears** (3 year book) This book will help you develop a breeding program, design a rabbitry, cull based on production, prevent diseases, develop sportsmanship, and develop a marketing plan.

**Book Requirements:** Complete 7 (seven) activities and page 3 each year. Helper initials are required. Bounding Ahead responses should be put on a separate sheet of paper and stapled into book where activity is located. For years 2 & 3 use different color ink. The animal record guide is required and due to your club leader in September along with your project book.
