****The Berkeley County 4-H Style Revue Judging will be held on Thursday, July 27th, 2017 from 9:00 a.m. until Noon at the Arden United Methodist Church Family Life Center located at 4464 Arden Nollville Road, Martinsburg, WV 25403**

- All sewing exhibitors are to check in by 9:15 a.m. Judging will begin at 9:30 a.m. and should be completed before noon.
- A picture of you wearing your garment will be taken before judging. The picture will then be attached to your sewing project exhibit during the 2017 Berkeley County Youth Fair with a second copy displayed in the 4-H Sewing Album.
- Bring any pattern/patterns that you have used to construct your garment.

****Saturday, August 5th 2017 drop off your garment at the Indoor Exhibit Hall – 11 AM to 1 PM.**

****All 4-H Sewing Exhibitors are to participate in the Style Revue Saturday evening, August 5th at 6:00 p.m. on the stage at the indoor arena. Ribbons and Sewing Awards will be presented that evening at the conclusion of the modeling.**

If a Sewing Exhibitor fails to send in the Description Sheet by July 17, 2017 or participate during the 4-H Style Revue judging, July 27, 2017, he/she will complete the project at the club level. Please contact Mrs. Frankenberry by July 10, 2017 if you have a conflict for the judging.

*****Your properly completed 2017 Description Sheet must be received by July 17, 2017 for you to be registered for the judging on July 27, 2017. Failure to meet this due date will result in the completion of your project at the club level, but NOT the county level, which is the Youth Fair.**
